Figure B.1. Neighbourhood-level difference in travel burden to language-concordant family physicians for the general population and for French-only speakers. Positive values (redder colouration) indicate excess travel burden for French-only speakers, negative values (bluer colouration) show reduced travel burdens. Colour scales are centred around 0 (light grey).
